

# NMMS Discipline Pyramid

- ★ All students start each 6 weeks with 100 points. Discipline offenses fall into one of five levels on the pyramid. Students lose points for misbehavior.
- ★ When a student's points fall below the following pre-determined levels, he/she receives the designated punishment:
  - 90-100 points – No punishment
  - 80-89 points – Diner's club (will now be held in Music Room 2 days a week)
  - 70-79 points – Detention
  - 60-69 points – ISS 3 days
  - 50-59 points – ISS 4 days
  - 40-49 points – ISS 5 days
  - 30-39 points – A-school
  - 20-29 points – suspension
  - below 20 points – District Discipline committee hearing
- ★ When a teacher takes points away and that causes a student to qualify for Diner's club or detention, that teacher will be responsible for assigning the punishment (fill out discipline card). If the student qualifies for ISS or greater, the teacher will refer the student to the office.
- ★ Failure to serve an assigned punishment will result in the loss of 5 points.
- ★ Offenses such as physical aggression, inappropriate language, disruptive behavior, etc. have varying levels of severity and administration may deduct more points or assign automatic consequences if deemed necessary.
- ★ Students may earn points back
  - Students who have lost points may gain those back from the teacher who took them
  - Students can earn points back by maintaining good behavior for a given amount of time- at the discretion of the teacher
  - No points may be earned back the last week of a 6 week grading period.
- ★ At the end of the 6-week grading period:
  - All students with at least 90 points will qualify for the reward activity (at least an hour long- i.e.-kickball tournament, talent show, etc).
  - All students with at least 80 points will qualify for a 20 minute reward break.
- ★ Students who maintain 100 points all year long will earn a trip to Holiday World in May.
